2009 Snow Run Recap and thank you to all who supported!

On behalf of Pink Ribbon Riders and all of the volunteers we would like to send a very big thank you to all of those that participated, donated time, donated items or services to the 2009 Snow Run events this January through March of 2009.

The Snow Run event is a unique event bringing together both men and women to help create awareness that breast cancer can happen to all of us. The disease touches so many more lives than just the one that is diagnosed.

Together the Snow Run events and the Pink Ribbon Riders bring together the local, regional and national people and companies that care about others. This year the Snow Run was held in 5 states across the USA in Minnesota, Michigan, Wisconsin, New York and Wyoming and raised close to \$200,000 for the cause!

Just a short 5 years ago, there was only one Snow Run and it raised \$2,500 and now in 2009 we are so honored to have 5 Snow Run events through out the USA and to be able to say that we have raised close to \$200,000 to help those diagnosed with breast cancer! It is amazing and we could not have done it with out your support.

In the fall of 2008 the Pink Ribbon Riders assistance program began and through the Fall of 2009 the program has helped more than 100 people diagnosed. The program has also assisted other grass roots efforts and programs by providing financial assistance to wig programs and educational breast cancer books to support groups.

As the main focus and mission of the Pink Ribbon Riders is to assist the patient directly, the organization saw this great need of support to these other grass roots efforts and did not look away.

We are proud to have supported the related breast cancer patient needs and are proud to relay to you that Pink Ribbon Riders has made a donation to anticipate a gas card and phone card program with the ST. John's Medical Foundation in Wyoming of \$3,000 this past March. The donation is directed to the breast cancer patients That live in rural areas and can not afford gas to treatments or visits with a support group. It is the first initiative of its kind at the center.
